Every quota dollar has gone to MPLT. Tarp for winter guard was paid for by LCPAA. Half from LN will be expecting a check. LN also owes 600\$ for winter percussion. The calendar dictates when the invoices come in. Not dealing with the socio-economic issues just the process issues that we have seen. Will need Directors and leaders in room with Board members. We do not have Quick books, or access to what is needed to dive deep to see more. We have had some staffing issues. May need to be administrative help as well. Need some clarity around to ensure that there are no class associated fees that are included

Keeping in mind that we all want the same thing- for our kiddos and to be successful in this.</p> <p>What do we want our next steps to be- bring to Kayla or take to Franklin? We may need to clear up what we want as final for LCPAA (redefining) in an effort to see what LN or MPLT may need to be clear on what is expected from all groups. Could we leverage this to see if Jeneen can send an the email with payment plans. We will not target the kids to give them the quota sheet or talk to them about their bill.</p> <p>MPLT- has payment scheduled on calendar. All MPLT students had their first check of 100\$ right when they are at Band Camp. They start out on a payment plan. On reveal night they have payment plan set up. And mandatory parent cook out with the first payment plan. Reports of who paid and reminders on Band App. Pay dues, be active in fundraising, or apply for scholarships.</p> <p>Give them the choice of pay in full, pay on payment plan or apply for scholarship.
