Anticipating will have final 2022/2023 stats end of this month or early April. Only things I still have on the list for LCPAA are shoes (want to discuss this with Jessica but not urgent for today - to confirm how to close out this season and how to plan for next season). Anticipating ending cash position will be similar as last season.</p> <p>- Met with DiaShamar last night to review some initial questions and budget proposal for 2023/2024 season: - He is currently assuming \$800 quota and \$150 subsidy from LN and LC. Current estimate is that we will have around 175 students (maybe 100 from LC, rest from</p>
